### Guidelines for registering a vehicle on Classic Registration (CVS)

Classic vehicles must be 30 years old or older from the year of manufacture, the registered operator of the vehicle must be a financial member of a car club that is affiliated with one of the associations that is a member of the "Australian Confederation of Motor Clubs" (ACMC) for club plate registration.

Classic vehicles must be garaged in NSW, under 3.5 tonne Gross Vehicle Mass and cannot be a plant vehicle or trailer, the final decision is with LPHCC NSW Inc.

#### Process:

- 1) Non-members must join LPHCC NSW Inc, complete our membership form and submit this to the club along with your membership payment.
- 2) LPHCC NSW Inc has a qualifying period of 12 months before a new member can be accepted to place their vehicle on Classic Registration, during this time you will need to attend a set number of meetings or outings during the year to be eligible as set out in our clubs constitution.
- 3) We would recommend the vehicle you wish to place on this registration is presented during this 12 month period for inspection by the club to confirm it complies with the RMS & LPHCC NSW Inc requirements for Classic Registration.
- 4) Once the qualifying period is over a valid "Unregistered Vehicle Inspection Report" (Blue Slip) will need to be obtained
- 5) Depending on the outcome of the "Blue Slip" inspection, an "Engineers Report" may be required if the vehicle does not comply with RMS guidelines in the "VSI-6 Modifications"
- 6) You will need to download the "Classic Vehicle Declaration" form from the RMS website and complete section one (1) and two (2)
- 7) Once a "Blue Slip" and "Engineers Report" (if required) is obtained and the "Classic Vehicle Declaration" has been completed, these documents will need to be presented to the club's executive committee.
- 8) LPHCC NSW Inc will then confirm if you are still a financial club member, provide the official club stamp, you will also need to complete some paperwork for LPHCC NSW Inc records.
- 9) For further verification and the ACMC stamp the original "Classic Vehicle Declaration" form, a **copy** of the "Blue Slip" and a stamped self addressed envelope can then be posted to:

11) The ACMC has a processing fee of \$25.00, this can be paid by cheque, money order or EFT

12) If paying by cheque or money order please include this with your documentation when you post it to the ACMC

13) If you wish to take advantage of the EFT option, please identify yourself clearly with your name on the transaction and include a transaction receipt with your documentation when you post it or email it to the ACMC

15) The forms will be posted or emailed back to you and must be taken to a Services NSW Office within the 42 days of Blue Slip issue

16) The Applicant will need to present:

- A completed "Application for Conditional Registration" form
- Proof of identity
- Proof of vehicle ownership – registration papers or receipt of sale
- The "Authorised Unregistered Vehicle Inspection Report" (Blue Slip)
- A completed "Classic Vehicle Declaration" form
- A completed "Change of Records" form to be included on the 60 day log book

17) Services NSW will issue new "Classic Vehicle" plates, these need to be attached to the front & rear of the vehicle and the registration label must be attached to the lower left section of the front windscreen or to a fixed window on the left side of the vehicle

18) Notify LPHCC NSW Inc "Club Plate Registrar" and "Public Officer" of the new registration number and registration due date

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
