Guidelines for registering a vehicle on Historic Registration (HVS)

Historic vehicles must be 30 years old or older from the year of manufacture, the registered operator of the vehicle must be a financial member of a Roads & Maritime Services recognized car club for club plate registration.

Historic vehicles must be garaged in NSW and as close to original as possible to meet the RMS and LPHCC NSW rules & regulations as set out in our "Club Registered Vehicle Constitution", this means no alterations except for safety features and period accessories, the final decision is with LPHCC NSW Inc.

Process:

- 1) Non-members must join LPHCC NSW Inc, complete our membership form and submit this to the club along with your membership payment.
- 2) LPHCC NSW Inc has a qualifying period of 12 months before a new member can be accepted to place their vehicle on Historic Registration, during this time you will need to attend a set number of meetings or outings during the year to be eligible as set out in our clubs constitution.
- 3) We would recommend the vehicle you wish to place on this registration is presented during this 12 month period for inspection by the club to confirm it complies with the RMS & LPHCC NSW Inc requirements for Historic Registration.
- 4) Once the qualifying period is over and the vehicle has been inspected and passed, a "Historic Vehicle Declaration" form will be required from the RMS and a valid "Pink Slip", these will need to be presented to the club's executive committee.
- 5) LPHCC NSW Inc will then confirm if you are still a financial club member, provide the official club stamp and sign the paperwork, you will also need to complete some paperwork for LPHCC NSW Inc records.
- 6) Attend a Services NSW Office in person and present:
 - A completed "Application for Conditional Registration" form
 - Proof of identity
 - Proof of vehicle ownership – registration papers or receipt of sale
 - A completed "Historic Vehicle Declaration" form
 - A Completed "Change of Records" form to be included on the 60 day log book
- 7) Services NSW will issue new "Historic Vehicle" plates, these need to be attached to the front & rear of the vehicle and the registration label must be attached to a fixed window on the front or passenger side of the vehicle.
- 8) Notify LPHCC NSW Inc "Club Plate Registrar" and "Public Officer" of the new registration number and registration due date.
